

### English

In English the children's writing will be based on a number of stories about Dragons. Children will be developing their descriptive writing as well as their own story openings. They will also be writing recounts of their work as Dragonologists.

### French

In French the children will be working on their French greetings and colours.

### Maths

Children will be following the White Rose scheme of work for maths. This term they will be covering place value and addition and subtraction. They will also be developing problem solving and reasoning skills.

### Geography

Our work in geography will involve exploring physical maps and using geographical vocabulary to describe places. (Especially places where dragons live!)

# YEAR 3 AUTUMN TERM 1 DRAGONOLOGY

### PSCHE

Children will follow Derbyshire's ASK scheme of work and focus on friendships, relationships and differences.

### RE

Children will be learning what Buddhism teaches us about how to react when life gets hard.

### PE

In PE children will be working on their gymnastic skills. They will work together and independently to create a routine that can be performed. Swimming sessions will be on a Thursday afternoon.

### Science

In science, children will investigate the similarities and differences between animals. They will start to understand how they can be sorted into different classifications.

### Art

Children will develop their observational drawing using a variety of mediums such as pencils, chalks and charcoals in order to carefully draw detailed sections of a dragon.

### Computing

As always we will be focussing on internet safety. The children will also be using the Microsoft Suite and learning how to use basic shape creation, fill tools and copy and paste techniques to create patterns and dragon scales.
