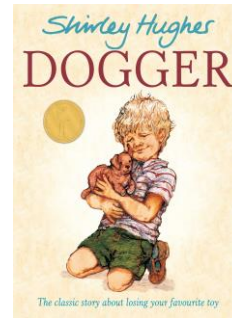


Communication, Language and Literacy

Design and make Christmas cards

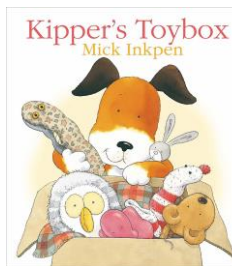


Toys and Games

Physical Development

Exploring and developing gross motor skills
Exploring and developing fine motor control and coordination
Forming recognisable letters
Handle tools safely and with increasing control, for example holding a pencil; using scissors to do crafts and make props

Mathematics

Counting, recognition and ordering of numbers zero to twenty
Matching numeral to quantity
One more/one less
Addition with two single digit numbers
Repeating patterns and sequencing
Following instructions
Use of comparative language when exploring weight
